Process	Foundation	Prayer
Invite Jesus into your life as your Lord and Saviour.	<p>"Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to men by which we must be saved." <i>Acts 4:12</i></p> <p>"For God so loved the world that he gave his one and only Son, that whoever believes in him shall not perish but have eternal life." <i>John 3:16</i></p> <p>"For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved." <i>Romans 10:10</i></p>	Dear Jesus, I invite you now to come into my life and heart and I surrender to You as my Lord and Saviour.
Confess all sins.	<p>"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just and will forgive us our sins and purify us from all unrighteousness." <i>1John 1:9</i></p> <p>"For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you confess and are saved." <i>Romans 10:10</i></p>	Dear Jesus, I choose to confess my sins of: ~ Pride – turning from you ~ Sexual sins ~ Idolatry ~ Envy ~ Gluttony ~ Slothfulness, etc.
Choose to forgive all people.	"Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you." <i>Colossians 3:13</i>	Lord, I choose to forgive ~ Mother ~ Father ~ Siblings ~ Relatives ~ Friends ~ Teachers ~ Others ~ for their offence against me.
Renounce and break all vows, curses, and mental agreements.	<p>"Rather, we have renounced secret and shameful ways; we do not use deception, nor do we distort the word of God. On the contrary, by setting forth the truth plainly we commend ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God." <i>2 Corinthians 4:2</i></p> <p>"Therefore say to the house of Israel, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: Repent! Turn from your idols and renounce all your detestable practices!'" <i>Ezekiel 14:6</i></p>	Lord, I renounce, reject and break the following thoughts to which I have been committed: ~ I will never .... ~ I hate ... ~ my secret clubs/associations
Invite Jesus into painful memories.	<p>"We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ." <i>2 Corinthians 10:5</i></p> <p>"The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to preach good news to the poor. He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion – to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of gladness instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair." <i>Isaiah 61:1-3</i></p>	Jesus, I invite You into this memory where I am ... ~ Lord, what is the lie or words connected with this memory? ~ Jesus, what is the truth related to the lie?
Invite Jesus into current thoughts.	"We demolish arguments and every pretension that sets itself up against the knowledge of God, and we take captive every thought to make it obedient to Christ." <i>2 Corinthians 10:5</i>	Jesus, I invite You into this specific thought in my mind ... Lord, what is the truth You want me to hear?
Choose to forgive yourself.	<p>"And the second (greatest commandment) is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.'" <i>Matthew 22:39</i></p> <p>"Godly sorrow brings repentance that leads to salvation and leaves no regret, but worldly sorrow brings death." <i>2 Corinthians 7:10</i></p>	Jesus, I choose to forgive myself for ... I now receive Your forgiveness and invite You to be with me now, and take my guilt away.
Choose to accept yourself now as a free child of God.	"It is for freedom that Christ has set us free. Stand firm, then, and do not let yourselves be burdened again by a yoke of slavery." <i>Galatians 5:1</i>	Jesus, I now choose to accept myself as a child of the Most High God, because You purchased me not because I am worthy.
Develop and strengthen your <i>True Self in Christ</i> story.	"Finally, brothers, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable – if anything is excellent or praiseworthy – think about such things. Whatever you have learned or received or heard from me, or seen in me – put it into practice. And the God of peace will be with you." <i>Philippians 4:8-9</i>	Share with others the newly found truths – dwell on God and His work in your life.
Live in the freedom and truth of Jesus Christ.	"Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth." <i>John 17:17</i>	Enjoy your <i>True Self in Christ</i> , Love God and Love others.
